- Band camp should be about the same as last year (\$300), may increase slightly to approximately \$310 depending on meals, motion to give \$150 discount for marching band camp for all 2017-2018 PTMB members(must be a member by commencement of band camp), motion by Karen Colainni, second by Fred Ensle, motion passed
- Budget 2017-2018, presented by Rochelle Koerbel, It was suggested and agreed to amend the band festival budget to \$5K by increasing "miscellaneous" category from \$300 to \$675. Motion by Laura Spernak to approve amended budget, second by Matt Campion, motion passed
- Lorne Hyskell, Marching Band Director, Greek Goddess filming Friday, May 26, need chaperones, color guard roster has been published, 125-135 marching band students for 2017-2018 school year, we may perform in DC Memorial Day 2018: Mr. Hyskell is working on details, included budget, drum line posted soon, marching band leadership most likely will be published on June 6
