The cost was \$330.00. We will need to budget this for next year. We are still covered for Band camp and other school activities, but we will need to see about Trax Farms.

The shed was budgeted for \$5000. It was able to be done at about \$2000. Many thanks again to Jordan Colaizzi and his parents for accomplishing this for the music boosters.
