

FINAL PTMB Booster Minutes for May 15, 2019

Amy Vogel called the meeting to order at 7:03 and led us in the pledge of allegiance.

In attendance: Amy Petro, Rochelle Koerbel, Amy Vogel, Milt Barney, and 19 booster members.

Minutes: Sue Dietzel made a motion to approve last month's minutes with a 2nd by Bob Racko. Approval passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Rochelle Koerbel presented the Treasurer's Report. The operating balance was presented as \$69,739.57. Brian Abt made a motion to approve the minutes with a second by Bob Racko.

Rochelle presented the budget for 2019-2020. She explained this represents foreseeable bills and a budget for next year that the Treasurer will pay on behalf of the boosters. Lisa Rothhaar made a motion to adopt the 2019-2020 budget. Rich Colaizzi seconded it and it was approved unanimously..

Committee Openings: Amy Petro discussed the committee openings for next year. After some discussion a few people graciously volunteered to fill a few of these positions. We are still looking for Hospitality for home and away football games, Parent tailgate (1 home football game early in the season), Communication blasts, Ensemble blasts and Sarris. **(NOTE: THESE POSITIONS HAVE BEEN FILLED SINCE THE DATE OF THE MEETING. Dine and Donates: Upcoming dine and donates are Kona, Ritas and Chipotle for August. Still waiting for checks from Juniper and Firehouse Subs.

Sarris Candy: We will be selling Sarris for the upcoming concerts. Anyone wishing to purchase a case should talk to Sue Dietzel.

Color guard raffle tickets: Robin shared that the color guard raffle was a success and they made \$3,982.

New Business

Trip Information and School Sponsor Update: Mr. Barney shared that they have hired someone for the Marching Band. Spencer Kun, a graduate from Bethel Park is our new Co-Director.

The next trip (in 2 years) will probably be somewhere in Florida. No official info at this time.

Nominating committee The boosters thanked Bob Racko, Debbie Langley and Amy Petro for serving on the committee. Lisa Rothhaar motioned to approve Rochelle Koerbel for President, Suzanne Mackay for Vice President, Amy Petro for Treasurer and Sue Dietzel for Secretary. Sharon Colaizzi seconded it and it was approved unanimously. Congratulations to our 2019-2020 Booster Board.

Senior Scholarships: There were 18 applicants and the 4 winners will be announced at the Senior Awards on June 4th. Names were not disclosed at the meeting as it is a surprise at the Senior Awards ceremony.

Band Festival: is September 28, 2019. Carrie Gallagher will chair this again. Debbie Langley has volunteered to do Candy Grams and Shout Outs again.

Marching Band Band Mini Camp: Mr. Barney announced Mini Camp will be June 10-11 from 9 to noon.

Slippery Rock band camp: Rochelle Koerbel opened the floor for discussions about a PTMB approved discount for Away Band Camp for August of 2019. In the past the discount has been \$150.00. The Board recommended a discount of \$175.00 for all band members who become PTMB members for the 2019-2020 year. MB members must pay for membership before camp in order to be eligible for the

discount. Sharon Colaizzi made a motion to offer a discount of \$175.00 for Away band camp, Brian Abt seconded it and it was unanimously approved.

Memorial Day Parade: Day of the parade, Report to the Middle school at 8am. They will be wearing summer uniforms – Red polos and black pants, black dinkles and black socks.

MB Uniform turn in/Raincoat turn in: Most items were turned in on the return date with a few still straggling in.

Spring Concert dates: these were sent out via eblast by the boosters and Shelley Belcher.

All concerts for the high school begin at 7:00 pm.

PTHS Choir Trip: The choir was invited by the Barbershop harmony festival to next year's festival in Jacksonville, FL. Dates are January **4/5-8th**, 2020. Barbershop society pays for the hotel costs for this trip Thursday-Sunday. Only costs are transportation and food and hotel Wednesday evening, if necessary. Mr. Perotte's plan is to go on this trip in 2020 and then skip 2021 so that the choir trip would be on opposite years from the "big" music department trip.
