5. Treasurer's Report – Michelle Skillings

- a. PTMB beginning balance of \$68,104.76 and ending balance of \$82,748.83
- b. Total income was \$22,166.19 membership, spirit wear, fundraisers
- c. Total expenses were \$7,522.12 fundraisers, equipment, snacks, uniform items, insurance, senior ad for yearbook
- d. Paypal balance is \$3,518.08
- e. With board turnover, PTMB got behind in filing taxes. Michelle is working on getting us caught up. A CPA (Michelle's Dad) is donating time to make sure this is accomplished by the end of the calendar year. Everything will be up to date by end of 2021.
