SUGGESTED PACKING LIST: March 22-27, 2022

Please note that this list is not intended to be all inclusive, but used as a guide. In addition to this list, students may wish to bring other items.

As our flight is on Southwest, students may check one bag and carry on a personal item (backpack etc). All students will check one bag. Please make sure all liquids are packed in the checked bag. Students must be able to handle their own baggage so don't pack a suitcase larger than you can handle please.

MASKS: MASKS ARE STILL REQUIRED ON PLANES AND AT THE AIRPORT SO PLEASE BRING A FEW MASKS WITH YOU. CURRENTLY, MASKS ARE OPTIONAL FOR FULLY VACCINATED GUESTS AT DISNEY AND UNIVERSAL STUDIOS BOTH INDOORS AND OUTDOORS. UNVACCINATED GUESTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO WEAR MASKS WHILE INDOORS. NEITHER DISNEY NOR UNIVERSAL STUDIOS REQUIRES VACCINATION CARDS. MASKS ARE REQUIRED FOR ENCLOSED TRANSPORTATION. PLEASE BRING MASKS SO WE HAVE THEM.

Weather in Orlando, Florida currently is fluctuating between 40-81 degrees. Also, it rains at some point in the day most days. Once we leave for the park in the morning we will not be returning to the hotel during the day and students will not have access to the busses. (with the exception of the MB and Room 100 on performance day). Students may wish to pack extra clothing. There is a laundry facility onsite if needed. There are also water rides in some of the parks so students may want a change of clothing. This is completely their choice.

ALL UNIFORMS MUST BE IN A GARMENT BAGS. GARMENT BAGS MUST HAVE THE STUDENT'S NAME IN THE OUTSIDE WINDOW. Students may put their dinkles in the garment bag. Recommend putting the black socks in the bag as well so everything is together.

Medication

With the exception of Epi-Pens, Inhalers and certain diabetic medication, students may not keep ANY medication with them or in their rooms. All medications must be turned in to the nurses when they arrive at the airport. THIS INCLUDES over the counter and/or prescription medication. Please consider buying the small bottles of over the counter medication if you are sending it "just in case" (Tylenol, benadryl, advil, allergy etc) so that there is just enough for the week. The nurses will have medication in their rooms and in the park so the students can access them when needed. ALL MEDICATIONS MUST be in their original containers and placed in a large, clear resealable bag. In addition to the OVERNIGHT MEDICATION FORM SIGNED BY YOUR PHYSICIAN ("OMF") turned in prior to the Trip, a copy of the OMF MUST placed in the clear resealable bag with the medications. Please place that form in the clear sealable bag AND

keep a copy for yourself. The overnight medication form is available on the ptmusicboosters.com website under "FORMS".

Snacks/Drinks

Each room has a mini refrigerator and a microwave.

If you wish, you can pack some snacks in your checked bags for the trip (granola bars etc).

IMPORTANT: Please note that each student will have their own key to their room. Students are responsible for keeping their rooms locked. Students are NOT permitted in each other's room. Neither PTSD nor the PTMB will be responsible for any lost or stolen items.
