1. Call to Order

a. 7:34 pm by Cari Williams with 26 people in attendance.

2. Approval of Minutes for September 21, 2022

3. Treasurer's Report – Julie Collins

- a. PTMB beginning balance for September was \$46,170.17; ending balance was \$60,577.56
- b. Motion to approve Treasurer's Report made by Anne Gavorcik, 2nd by Stacy Henderson. Approved unanimously.

4. 50th Anniversary Celebration

- a. Event was well received by all who attended. Alumni enjoyed returning and requested that we host an alumni night every year. Current members loved interacting with the past band members.
- b. We are hoping to make this an annual, albeit smaller, event to coincide with homecoming. We will work on figuring out the details in the off season.

5. Middle School Participation Night – October 14, 2022

- a. Middle school students will march and perform with the band during pregame on Friday evening. A little over 20 kids have signed up and have attended practice this week.
- b. The students will stay with the band in the stands for the first half of the game, then watch the halftime show from the front of the field.
- c. We have included color guard for the first time this year.

6. Marching Band Banquet – November 13, 2022

- a. The banquet will be held at the Hilton Garden Inn from 3 8pm. Dinner will be served at 4pm, followed by awards at 5pm, and dancing from 6-8pm. This is a semi-formal event.
