

PTMB Booster Meeting General Membership
March 9, 2023

1. Call to Order
 - a. 6:45 pm by Cari Williams with 21 people in attendance.
2. Approval of Minutes for February 9, 2023
 - a. Motion made by Brian Hyjurick, 2nd by Anne Gavorcik. Approved unanimously.
3. Treasurer's Report – Rochelle Koerbel
 - a. The February 9, 2023 balance was \$113,855.69. The current balance is \$82,457.98. Large payments were made for the Choir trip discount and lottery calendar payouts.
 - b. The PTMB has received donations totaling \$458.19 from members to the EF Fire Relief fund. That check will be written this month to Elizabeth Forward. Once that check is written, the balance will be \$81,999.79. The PTMB also previously donated \$500.00.
 - c. There was a bookkeeping error in January. A lottery check was entered into the books as \$100.00 instead of \$50.00. When cashed in February, the correction was made to the January lotto winning line item on the financials from \$1000 lottery winnings in January to \$950.00.
 - d. We have a number of uncashed checks on our books. If you have an uncashed check (or know someone who does), please cash it.
 - c. Motion to pay the bills for February made by Mylaina Sherwood, 2nd by Kim Mitchell Approved unanimously.
4. Senior Scholarship - Rochelle Koerbel
 - a. The PTMB will offer Six - \$1000.00 scholarships to eligible seniors.
 - b. To be eligible, a student's family must be current members of the PTMB as of December 20, 2022.
 - c. Students must fill out an application and write a 500 word essay and submit it by May 1, 2023 at 2:30 pm (via email perrotter@pt-sd.org) to Mr. Perrotte.
 - d. Applications will be available online (ptmusicboosters.com), blasted to families, provided to teachers and posted on the BAND APPs.
 - e. Essays are blind judged. The PTMB board has no involvement in the judging of the applications.

- f. Six students with the top scores (based upon their involvement in the PTHS music department and essay scores) will receive their awards at the June 6, 2023, Senior Awards banquet at 6:00 pm.
5. Nominating Committee for 23-24
 - a. The PTMB membership will vote on the Board positions at the May, 2023 membership meeting.
 - b. The Bylaws require the membership to create a Nominating Committee of 3 individuals to seek candidates which will be presented at the April 9, 2023 meeting.
