- ♪ **All ticket sales will be via the PTMB website.** We need everyone's help to sell tickets to family, friends, and neighbors in advance. Tickets will be available at the door but it helps tremendously when placing our food orders if the majority of tickets are sold in advance.
- ♪ **Interactive music opportunity for younger guests in the Black Box.** Our Black Box interactive space was a big hit with our younger guests last year. We will continue to offer this unique experience for them to interact with our talented PTHS musicians in a hands-on musical environment.
- ♪ **Students will work in shifts and be permitted to support their peers during their performance window.** Band students will work the first half of the evening while the Choir and Orchestras perform and the Choir and Orchestra students will work the second half of the evening while the Band students perform. Sign-ups for student volunteers will take place after the winter break.

- # **Each family is asked to sell 10 adult tickets and as many child tickets as you can.** Adult meal tickets are available at a pre-sale price of \$15 through January 29, 2026. Afterwards, they will be \$20. Children's meals for guests 12 and under are \$10.
- # **We offer discounted pricing on our basket raffle tickets when purchased in advance.** One sheet of raffle tickets includes 26 chances to win and costs \$20 per sheet. If you purchase 3 sheets, you receive a 4th sheet free. This promotional pricing is only available prior to the event.
